Two shifts are available: check-in for the morning shift is at 8:00AM; check-in for the afternoon shift is at 1:00PM. Check-in is at Northpark Baptist Church, 5700 Deerfoot Parkway, Trussville, 35173. On Thursday, 1/26, volunteers should bring a sack lunch; thereafter, lunch will be provided.
